SNEEZING 100

Child 5: We sent our researchers into the field to FIND OUT.

Child 6: It didn't take them long to discover the BAD NEWS.

Child 7: How do YOU sneeze?

Class (in turn): ATCHOO! ATCHOO! ATCHOO! ATCHOO! ATCHOO! ATCHOO!

Child 8: In our sample, most people used their HANDS to cover their sneezes.

Child 9: But very few WASH their hands after sneezing.

Child 10: That's just GROSS!

Child 11: This means most sneezers CONTAMINATE everything they TOUCH with

their GERM-COVERED HANDS.

Child 12: YUCK!

Child 13: NEW research shows that the SAFEST way to sneeze is IN YOUR SLEEVE!

Child 14: This way the germs get TRAPPED IN THE FABRIC and then DIE without spreading.

Child 15: Now let's see some examples of PROPER sneezing technique.

Class - in turn: ATCHOO! ATCHOO! ATCHOO! ATCHOO! ATCHOO! ATCHOO!

Child 16: Now THAT'S more like it!

Whole class: So NEXT time you feel that TICKLE in your nose,

SNEEZE IN YOUR SLEEVE!
